

SUPER LEAGUE – format for the 18/19 Winter Season

- 1) 9 players in each division and over a 4 evening season, all 9 will play one another once – 8 matches in all.
- 2) 3 players at each venue to start at 7.00pm and following a round robin with 6 frames per match played, the odd one out to referee and time keep – so with 3 matches in total, each player plays 2 matches on the night.
- 3) 1 point per frame with the 2 point win bonus and if the match is tied at 3-3, then 1 point goes to each player.
- 4) Each match is allocated 75 minutes, so starting at 7.00pm, match 2 must start at 8.15pm with the 3rd match starting at 9.30pm. Should any match possibly overrun, then the frame tally at 75 minutes will be the final score and if either player has reached 4 frame wins, then he/she receives the 2 point win bonus.
- 5) If a player wishes to lay a snooker, then this has to involve the use of a cushion after contact – rolling up will cause a foul. **On all shots, the player must: cause the cue ball's initial contact with a ball to be with a ball "On", AND THEN EITHER pot a ball "On" OR cause the Cue Ball or any Object Ball to contact a cushion.**
- 6) In the event you have been placed in a full ball snooker, you may call a total snooker. Providing the ref agrees you will be able to contact your object ball without hitting a cushion, if the player doesn't call the total, then it would be a foul if you don't hit a cushion or pot a ball after contact.
- 6) The one minute rule to be observed and match results to be in within 24 hours.
- 7) From the break off shot, should the white ball drop – this will only give the oncoming player ONE shot, to encourage a more open break without the severity of our two shots carried – all other fouls are two carried.
- 8) One element of the skill shot will be allowed and if an opponents ball is potted, then this has to include the potting of one of your own colour within that shot and NOT the black ball and always after having struck your own colour first. ***However, a separate shot must be played to pot the black ball and win the game.***
- 9) League tables and individual performance tables will be going on the website – just as the teams stats do currently.
- 10) The entry fee of £10 per player will be divided up into the winner and placed players prize monies.
- 11) Matches to be played (if possible), on Wednesdays in every month and should any player be unable to commit to any match date then it is up to him/her to rearrange the match night to an EARLIER date, or lose all points for that date, but where ever possible – opponents must try and cooperate with this.
- 12) The 4 tables selected for each division will require the landlord's agreement for the freeplay facility.
- 13) The season to start in September and conclude at Christmas. The top players in each division will be invited to a finals night in the new year to decide an overall champion.
